Location: Prince George Roll-a-Dome*, 2588 Recreational Place

Directions: Located at the corner of Highway 16 and Highway 97. Access is from the road marked by the Golf & Curling club sign on Highway 16 located between the major highways intersection and the East Side Mario's and Real Canadian Superstore.


